Creative Fingal proudly presents Cruinniú na nÓg; a day of free creativity for young people on 6 June, 2026. All ten library branches will host *Carnivals of Curiosity*, with creative events to engage and delight the community. Author and illustrator visits, graffiti workshops, manga art, music, dancing and much more will make it a day to remember.

We Own the Castle returns to Swords Castle, hosted by Garageland Galaxy. This music festival, exclusively tailored for teenagers, will feature live performances from young talent on two stages. *The Chapel Sessions* offer poetry and unplugged music. The hugely popular *Wavin' Words* Youth Slam Poetry Stage - this year's Cruinniú Late event - gives young performers the chance to slam, perform, speak or read... the open mic is yours! Meanwhile, the *Creative Village* will enhance the festival vibe, allowing young people to customise their look for the day!

Drop into the Draíocht Arts Centre, Blanchardstown for the Colourings Family Day. Create and play in this vibrant Creative Response Space with artists Sarah Ward and Michelle Hall. Taking inspiration from Lucy Hill's exhibition *Colourings* - where exciting shapes and bold colours collide - families are invited to explore colour, shape and markmaking together through hands-on creative activities. Young audiences can also experience *OutLine*, an immersive dance performance by Selma Daniel Dance, inspired by the playful energy and colourful scribbles of the exhibition. *Wonder Walls Graffiti Workshops* with Waterford Walls will return once again, encouraging young people to design and paint murals collaboratively, celebrating creativity and self-expression.

The Séamus Ennis Arts Centre in Naul, Co. Dublin will mark Cruinniú na nÓg with a vibrant programme of hands-on workshops and performances. Young creatives can step into the magical world of Shadow Puppetry through interactive workshops and live performances, try their hand at a traditional *Bodhrán Making Workshop*, or join the fun at a Circus Céilí with Circus Explored.

With something for everyone this June 6th, make sure to book your place!

Meet Fingal's Local Ambassador, Yasmine Al Ja Afrehova!

Tell us about yourself

Well, to start off I'm the daughter of a Palestinian father and a Czech mother. I am the only one in my family to have been born in Ireland. From time to time it can cause sparks of loneliness within different aspects of my life. It's during this time that I choose to engross myself into the cathartic and cerebral life of poetry. To me, poetry, my form of creativity, is the window to my soul. It allows me to express myself in a manner that does not fully expose me and yet offers an insight to my life.

Earliest memory of creativity or creative accomplishment

My earliest memory of a creative accomplishment came with no physical reward. During dark times I was bereft of any true feeling. My head was a storm of chaos and reason. I had not allowed myself to talk about it with anyone for a long time. It was one day on a school writing task that I allowed my thoughts to drown my page in my

emotion. As I sat back from my desk to read once more what I wrote, tears like rivers ran down my cheeks. Emotion. My writing allowed me to feel the emotion I so desperately craved. It did not matter what I did feel. It is that I could feel. That was the most beautiful reward of all. However, it's safe to say I wrote something else before handing in my assignment.

When/how did you begin your favourite creative activity?

My parents are both accomplished singers and musicians, so I grew up around music without even realising it! We'd always sing together and have fun. I love acting and I started when I was 5 in a local drama school. I go to Little Duke Theatre at the moment, and we are currently rehearsing for our upcoming show, Sister Act. I am playing Eddie which is a lot of fun.

When/how did you begin your favourite creative activity?

Poetry has followed me throughout my life. My eyes have always hungrily searched for words driven by rhythm and rhyme. Due to a workshop from

school, I was allowed to meet and work with a wonderful woman who has aided me in continuing reading out my poetry for the public. Being able to read my poetry while others listen has always been a dream of mine. To me, it establishes a connection from me to the listener. Even if just for a moment, I wish for my struggle to be seen in someone else's eyes.

How do you feel when you're being creative?

It's simple really, I feel alive. Not in a vivacious nor chaotic way, it's much more difficult to describe. I feel as though I am living and not dead, which sadly doesn't sound a poetic as I wish it could. In a life of continuous struggle, of storms of emotion and rapids of uncertainty, there are pauses. For me those pauses contain poetry, the blueprints of me being human. So when I am being creative, I feel the ocean's waters still, I feel the sandstorm dying down and most of all, I feel me.

What advice would you give other young people to encourage their creativity?

Creativity knows no bounds. And it never should. To allow yourself to be creative, you must first be vulnerable with yourself. There is no one on the planet who knows and understands you more than you do. So trust yourself, trust your hand and trust your mind.

Who is your creative hero and why?

I have never really called someone

my creative hero nor aspiration. However, one woman called Holly Hughes comes to mind. It wasn't until I attended a poetry event late last year, did I see her. She was mesmerizing. She did a piece of slam poetry about Palestine and it's supporters called "we are". Initially you might think I hold bias since it recounts of my father's homeland, but you'd be mistaken. It was Holly's ability to express humanity serving together as a whole. That pain was shared not simply just felt by one nation. It was her ability that caused such admiration in me, the way she spoke to a crowd and yet, felt like she was just speaking to me.

Finish the sentence, 'creativity is...'

Creativity is the window to the soul, it comes in many different ways to express it, and hide it.

In your own words, what's the best thing about Ireland having Cruinniú na nÓg, a national day celebrating creativity for young people?

Cruinniú na nÓg allows for the birth of new creation and connections right at the tips of your fingers. It allows young people to express themselves without feelings of dread nor worry of their talent. It gives the youth an outlet to spark their creativity. It is accessible to anyone with a willingness to do it!
